The St. Mark's Heritage Foundation of St. Mark's Anglican Church will play host at The Dick and Jane LeVan Theatre, Trinity College School, Port Hope on May 7, 2010 to a one-night only performance of The Three Cantors, three musically trained Anglican priests from Southern Ontario whose concerts include anything from Broadway to folk to spirituals to ancient church music and lots of humour along the way. The Cantors are acclaimed for their amazing blend of voices: both solo and together, choice of music: much to make you laugh, a few to bring a tear, some quick changes and sing-a-longs. A humble beginning, singing at a church event in 1997, has led to some surprising success.

Their concerts, which regularly sell out, have been performed live across Canada, on TV and radio, and before the Governor General.

Proceeds from the concert will benefit the St. Mark's Heritage Foundation whose long-standing mission is the restoration and preservation of its historic church building on King Street, the oldest public building in Port Hope. None of the money raised by the Foundation goes to the activities of the church. The Cantors' performance fee will support The Primate's World Relief and Development Fund.

"A Three Cantors Concert is a celebration of the power of music to bring joy, hope and faith in Christ to bear on the challenges of a world of people in need....and to have a great time doing it."
