the sacristy, for use around the church.



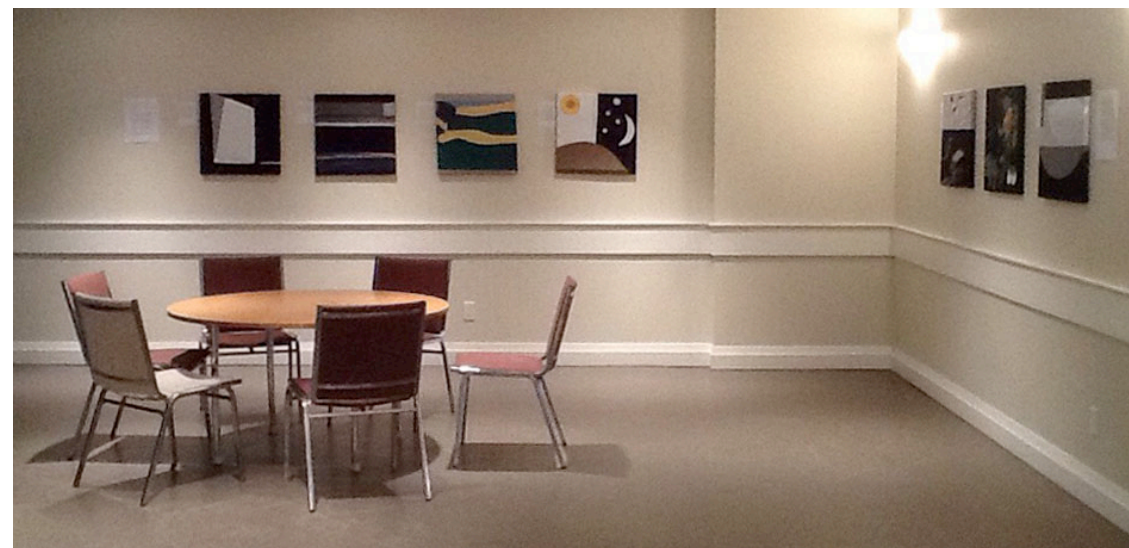
