

## The Reverend Canon Ann Smith



Ann was born in the Niagara Diocese, raised in Toronto. Following Grade 13 at St. Mildred's College, she attended Teacher's College and taught for two years in St. Philip's Indian Residential School in Fort George, Quebec. She graduated from Trinity College, University of Toronto in 1969 with an Honour B.A. in Music.
